Cataracts

A cataract is a clouding or haze of the lens inside the eye which leads to a decrease in vision. Opacities in the lens obstruct light from passing through and being focused on to the retina.

Symptoms

- Reduced or hazy vision
- Increased glare sensitivity
- Reduced contrast (need for bright lights to read)
- Double vision
- Problems distinguishing colours

Causes

- Age is the most common cause
- UV exposure (over many years)
- Blunt trauma, Ionizing radiation (X-rays), Laser, Electric and heat injuries
- Cigarette smoking (2-3 x higher risk)
- Steroid use

Prevention and Treatment

- UV protection
- Don't smoke
- Healthy diet (antioxidants may help reduce risk)
- Regular eye examinations (can help with symptoms)
- Referral to ophthalmologist (for cataract extraction)
